**Jeff Tatanus:** okay, so young people would be our main target.

**WKUComanche:** i think so

**Jeff Tatanus:** since they would be the most open to new technology

**WKUComanche:** exactly

**Jeff Tatanus:** we're just getting into it anyway

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**Jeff Tatanus:** since they will be the most open to new technology

**Jeff Tatanus:** what is the incentive for them to use this?

**photobypip:** Im kinda leaning tward the idea that participation would be enough of an incentive

**Jeff Tatanus:** reason to read it.

**photobypip:** everyone likes to be listened to

**photobypip:** well the reason to read it is its community journalism

**pagreen@mac.com:** And to read about things that normally don't make the news.

**photobypip:** right

**Jeff Tatanus:** such as?

**photobypip:** but wit what we talked about last nite "real" news stories would be posted alongside cit journalism

**Jeff Tatanus:** right

**Jeff Tatanus:** what would "something that doesnt normally make the news" be?

**photobypip:** I dont know I havnt read it yet

**pagreen@mac.com:** I didn't have anything specific in mind.

**WKUComanche:** happy hour specials?

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**photobypip:** Thats the whole thing, it could be anything

**Jeff Tatanus:** right, but i just think we should have a good example for our presentation

**WKUComanche:** i thought the cit contributed were augmentations to the hard news

**photobypip:** I think the prospect of fnding something unexpexted that is in your community is a big incentive to participate

**Jeff Tatanus:** i wouldnt say augmentations

**Jeff Tatanus:** i would say they would be just as important

**Jeff Tatanus:** right?

**photobypip:** So we need to come up with an example

**photobypip:** of good cit journalism

**photobypip:** if it exists

**Jeff Tatanus:** well good hyperlocal cit journ

**pagreen@mac.com:** Mapping minor vandalism incidents?

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**WKUComanche:** that seems trivial

**Jeff Tatanus:** u would say high school sports could work

**WKUComanche:** it's a good example but not one that would inspire me to read

**pagreen@mac.com:** Not if you live in those neighborhoods.

**WKUComanche:** maybe you're right

**WKUComanche:** good point

**pagreen@mac.com:** High school sports are usually covered, aren't they?

**photobypip:** Mapping of petty theft neighborhood breakins

**WKUComanche:** high school sports could be better covered by the community

**photobypip:** the petty teft usually isnt in the paper and would work well with the map format

**Jeff Tatanus:** true

**pagreen@mac.com:** But do sports really benefit from the mapping idea?

**Jeff Tatanus:** not really

**Jeff Tatanus:** i was thinking really local news

**Jeff Tatanus:** but yeah, small crime works

**Jeff Tatanus:** or what else? i think we need some good solid examples

**pagreen@mac.com:** What was the original question? Incentives to read?

**Jeff Tatanus:** yes

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**photobypip:** What about gas prices at diffrent pumps

**Jeff Tatanus:** already done

**Jeff Tatanus:** gasbuddy.com?

**photobypip:** but not synergized

**pagreen@mac.com:** Synergized?

**photobypip:** put it on the map with all the other news

**photobypip:** that way its already in peoples daily routine

**Jeff Tatanus:** i feel like thats way too much data

**pagreen@mac.com:** Yeah, that might get crowded.

**photobypip:** but if ou make the content filterable, people could only view the content they wanted

**photobypip:** ie gas prices, crime, sports

**Jeff Tatanus:** so make different layers that can be turned on?

**photobypip:** ya

**photobypip:** similar to google earth

**Jeff Tatanus:** so we could have... newspaper news, gas prices, crime, sports

**photobypip:** exactly

dryambor has joined this chat.

**photobypip:** make each layer like a page of the paper

**photobypip:** sports

**photobypip:** buisness

**photobypip:** classifieds

**pagreen@mac.com:** Good idea. The trade-off is that you lose that element of opening the paper and seeing something that you wouldn't look for.

**Jeff Tatanus:** wow, thats even more craigslist-meets-googlemaps

**Jeff Tatanus:** the main view could just be top stories from all of them...

**photobypip:** ya i kinda like it

**pagreen@mac.com:** Okay.

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**Jeff Tatanus:** marjorie, what do you think?

**dryambor:** just arrived, so i don't think i got the full scope...

**WKUComanche:** are we doing an interface map for news headlines?

**dryambor:** i picked up at the layers as pages of a paper.

**Jeff Tatanus:** like sections of a newspaper

**dryambor:** right.

**dryambor:** catch me up?

**Jeff Tatanus:** philip, could you explain?

**photobypip:** Basically the map interface is where all the local news stories are displayed

**dryambor:** ok...

**photobypip:** then by clicking on the layers the viewer wants to see they can look at the stories close to them

**photobypip:** the community can post their own stories with a built in web application

**photobypip:** much like an html form or email

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**photobypip:** the map would have ton of sortable searchable info on it

**Jeff Tatanus:** craigslist ish?

**dryambor:** how will the layers display?

**photobypip:** arrainged geographically

**photobypip:** each post is givin a catagory

**Jeff Tatanus:** the layers can be turned on or off

**dryambor:** mr. t., you need to move to a bigger city so you can satisfy your craigslist fetish. 😊

**photobypip:** if the user checks that catagory all the listings appear on the map

**Jeff Tatanus:** hey, rochester has craigslist 😊

**dryambor:** i'm sure it does!

**photobypip:** ya but dc has a better one

**dryambor:** i doubt bowling green has anything...

**photobypip:** they just got one

**dryambor:** do you have any idea of the potential site display? or is the katrina link last night pretty close to what you're envisioning?

**Jeff Tatanus:** is everyone familiar with craigslist?

**pagreen@mac.com:** Basically.

**photobypip:** i think a google maps type interface would be best

**WKUComanche:** i've seen it

**photobypip:** it is technology that everyone is familier with

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**dryambor:** ok...just always trying to get that mental image secured.

**photobypip:** so is this what we're gunna go with or does anyone have anymore imput or seggestions

**WKUComanche:** you're right on in my understanding

**pagreen@mac.com:** Looks fine to me.

**Jeff Tatanus:** marjorie, did you see the mapplets?

**dryambor:** sorry...student walked in...

**Jeff Tatanus:** ah, okay

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**Jeff Tatanus:** they have an earthquake mapplet

**Jeff Tatanus:** and chicagocrime is available on there

**dryambor:** i have closed my office door and am looking...

**WKUComanche:** i see the map but not the content

**Jeff Tatanus:** check the left side panel

**photobypip:** so what do we need to lay out for our presentation

**Jeff Tatanus:** a detailed explanation

**dryambor:** do you plan to focus on the whole country for your project, or a city...region...etc.?

**Jeff Tatanus:** i would say a region... since we dont know what organization will pick us up

**Jeff Tatanus:** although it could be national

**Jeff Tatanus:** what does everyone else think?

**WKUComanche:** definately regional

**photobypip:** the format would be best kept regional

**Jeff Tatanus:** the how of participating

**Jeff Tatanus:** reader and submitter

**dryambor:** just need to determine how you want it look, function, etc.

**Jeff Tatanus:** and how do we handle a massive influx of stories?

**Jeff Tatanus:** digg style?

**pagreen@mac.com:** I don't expect a huge influx.

**Jeff Tatanus:** really? but what if...

**photobypip:** It need to be edited by a journalist

**pagreen@mac.com:** The paper I work at has a designated online journalist.

**Jeff Tatanus:** so would the most important stories show up on a big view

**photobypip:** Thats what I was thinking

**Jeff Tatanus:** and then when you zoom in, the most insignificant stories appear?

**photobypip:** the more important stories have bigger type face

**Jeff Tatanus:** but arent they just appearing as icons?

**photobypip:** but if the bigger stories had bigger circles it would accomplish the same thing

**Jeff Tatanus:** or darker circles?

**dryambor:** or red stars...

**Jeff Tatanus:** ??

**photobypip:** I was thinking they would e color coded based on they layer hey were assigned to

**dryambor:** kidding.

**Jeff Tatanus:** agreed about layer coloring

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**photobypip:** ok so how are we gunna present this

**photobypip:** I think I can illustrate it in flash

**Jeff Tatanus:** how do we prioritize/rank stories?

**photobypip:** by the size of the icon

**photobypip:** bigger circle, bigger story

**Jeff Tatanus:** size?

**Jeff Tatanus:** and then take up more space?

**pagreen@mac.com:** I'll have to go in a minute- I have to pick up my sister.

**photobypip:** Ya i think its the most visual and simple way to do it

**dryambor:** could get cluttered quickly.

**Jeff Tatanus:** why not color?

**Jeff Tatanus:** \*shade

**photobypip:** color for the layers

**Jeff Tatanus:** like brighter/darker?

**pagreen@mac.com:** That's true. But what about color-blind people?

**Jeff Tatanus:** they can still tell brightness/darkness

**photobypip:** i think size would be simpler to understand

**photobypip:** and space wouldnt be a huge issue

**photobypip:** shade is just confusing

**Jeff Tatanus:** okay

**Jeff Tatanus:** so like the smallest icons wouldnt appear on the main screen unless there were no other stories?

**photobypip:** right

**Jeff Tatanus:** and who decides how "big" a story is?

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**photobypip:** it could be a user rating system or an editor rating system

**Jeff Tatanus:** user rating - like digg?

**photobypip:** not really because the stories would still have to go through an editor

**pagreen@mac.com:** We should have a journalist in this somewhere. And I have to get going. Could you let me know when we're chatting again?

**Jeff Tatanus:** i dunno...

**photobypip:** when does our next chat need to be

**Jeff Tatanus:** marjorie?

**dryambor:** sorry...mr. edge actually sent a student up here to knock on my closed door. 😊

**dryambor:** ok...

WKUComanche has joined this chat.

**WKUComanche:** disconnected some how, sorry

**dryambor:** hello mr. edge. i was just blaming you for my short absence from the chat. garret (sp?) just stopped in.

**Jeff Tatanus:** he was here.

**WKUComanche:** sorry i confused him with jon

**WKUComanche:** i realized as soon as i typed

**photobypip:** its cool

**dryambor:** yeah...just curious...has anyone checked the other team blogs to see what they've done as far as presentation?

**Jeff Tatanus:** kim's team dissolved.

**dryambor:** totally?

**Jeff Tatanus:** yep

**photobypip:** why

**dryambor:** what happened?

**photobypip:** how

**photobypip:** im so shocked

**Jeff Tatanus:** "your group ok? mine disintegrated completely - i put hte one good kid in another group so he didn't get totally screwed"

**dryambor:** was that on their blog?

**Jeff Tatanus:** she IMed me

**dryambor:** no mention on the faculty blog...

**Jeff Tatanus:** kgregson

**dryambor:** ok.

**dryambor:** i posted what i told you guys last night as far as format on the faculty blog and requested feedback, but i haven't heard anything.

**photobypip:** so where do we begin with our presentation

**dryambor:** hang on just a sec...let's check the other teams to see if anyone's posted theirs.

**photobypip:** we start with an overview of our idea

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**photobypip:** ok

**Jeff Tatanus:** why dont we start with the problem?

**Jeff Tatanus:** build up to it...

**photobypip:** ok

**photobypip:** whats the problem

**Jeff Tatanus:** people not going online for local news

**Jeff Tatanus:** right?

**photobypip:** right

**photobypip:** then from there we introduce geotagged stories

**dryambor:** ok...i don't see any presentations up yet. what team was kim's?

**dryambor:** group 2?

**Jeff Tatanus:** i think

**photobypip:** then layers

**photobypip:** and finally cit submissions

**Jeff Tatanus:** yes

**Jeff Tatanus:** why dont we give examples of current technology

**Jeff Tatanus:** like google mapplets

**Jeff Tatanus:** and chicagocrime

**Jeff Tatanus:** and... you know.

**photobypip:** lol craigslist

**dryambor:** jeff...i understand your wanting to start with the problem, but i'm not sure i would be that comprehensive just yet.

**Jeff Tatanus:** why?

**dryambor:** i think the darker details you should save for the final presentation...

**dryambor:** well, if you're ready to give it now, that's cool.

**photobypip:** ok so lets do no problem and no current technology

**dryambor:** it just sounded like you guys may not be ready with it, but if you are, rock on.

**photobypip:** just a sneak preview of the brilliance to come

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**Jeff Tatanus:** what is our future plan tho?

**photobypip:** If you give me a couple weeks I might be able to build this thing

**Jeff Tatanus:** like do we continue to refine this?

**dryambor:** i have a suspicion that i've already told you to do more than necessary with what i told you last night.

**photobypip:** do we still need a presentation today

**dryambor:** yes, presentation today.

**Jeff Tatanus:** ok

**dryambor:** but it's a presentation of your IDEA, not your whole project.

**WKUComanche:** i think a working definition would help a lot

**dryambor:** consequently, yes, you will continue to refine your details as you work on your project/ presentation for ithaca.

**photobypip:** so what is included in our idea

**dryambor:** that's the second step i mentioned last night: state your project.

**Jeff Tatanus:** geotagging of stories

**Jeff Tatanus:** (georss format)

**WKUComanche:** i geotags and cit journalism

**dryambor:** until you have an easy definition, even you won't know what you're talking about.

**dryambor:** and i'm sure you have a name now, right? 😊

**Jeff Tatanus:** what was the quint... name?

**dryambor:** prime radical 3 quintesson

**WKUComanche:** your idea?

**Jeff Tatanus:** yeah, i dunno...

**dryambor:** i CAN'T GIVE YOU ONE!!! or it would be totally cool. 😊

**Jeff Tatanus:** haha

**photobypip:** ok so how do we turn our idea into a presentation

**dryambor:** that's the hardest part of this project: i have to just watch and input...no...thing of any consequence.

**dryambor:** i gave you the slides last night, dude.

**photobypip:** slides?

**Jeff Tatanus:** check the transcript, philip.

**photobypip:** ok

**dryambor:** you're having a monday mind

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**WKUComanche:** "monday mind" i like that

**dryambor:** :0

**Jeff Tatanus:** case of the mondays...

**dryambor:** i like \*headdesk\* best!

**dryambor:** and i have many a cool suit to go with the title!!!

**dryambor:** i'm countless planet.

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**Jeff Tatanus:** that works...

**WKUComanche:** Incubators Of The Digital Filthy Incubators Incubators Eye Incubators Lassie Drunk Incubators Incubators Flame And The Incoming Bleach Incubators Thirsty Incubators Breeze Incubators Of The Open Incubators Howdy

**WKUComanche:** these came off a rock band name generator with incubators in the description

**Jeff Tatanus:** can we make it into a movie reference?

**WKUComanche:** transformers?

**photobypip:** no

**WKUComanche:** vetoed

**Jeff Tatanus:** drunk incubators would be bad...

**Jeff Tatanus:** right.

**Jeff Tatanus:** hmm

**photobypip:** how about "untitled"

**Jeff Tatanus:** i like it

**dryambor:** cheating

**Jeff Tatanus:** or TBA... with TBA standing for something

**Jeff Tatanus:** the best acronym?

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**Jeff Tatanus:** ya there?

**dryambor:** maps, mapping, news, no borders, community...

**dryambor:** uh huh...

**Jeff Tatanus:** innovators without borders

**dryambor:** 🙄

**photobypip:** sounds good

**Jeff Tatanus:** then that it is.

**Jeff Tatanus:** ryan?

**WKUComanche:** i'll go with it

**WKUComanche:** kinda long but it works

**Jeff Tatanus:** IWB for short

**dryambor:** you guys would go for anything at this point!

**dryambor:** how does it apply to what you're doing?

**dryambor:** too philosophical for today, so that's fine. just think on it.

**Jeff Tatanus:** well first of all, we are thinking outside the traditional "box" of journalism

**Jeff Tatanus:** and we are working on geographic stuff

**WKUComanche:** we're definitely not the geotags

**WKUComanche:** let's keep thinking on it

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**Jeff Tatanus:** ok

**dryambor:** ok.
